

## Do I Qualify for an Overnight Parking Permit?


1. All vehicles must be registered with the California DMV to the Brea address where they are parked.
2. Your residence must be within 100 ft. from a public street on which parking is allowed.
3. Single Family Residences may qualify for a maximum of (2) overnight parking permits.
4. Townhomes, apartments and condominiums may qualify for a maximum of (1) overnight parking permit.

### Questions:

- How many vehicles do you have?
- How many on-site parking spaces do you have?
  - a. All available on-site parking spaces must be used (except for allowing one (1) space in two (2) car garage).


### Example 1:

I have four (4) vehicles and three (3) on-site parking spaces.  
– This qualifies for one (1) parking permit.



### Example 2:

I have three (3) vehicles and three (3) on-site parking spaces.  
– This does **not** qualify for a parking permit.



### How do I apply for a permit?

- Visit the city's website: [www.cityofbrea.gov](http://www.cityofbrea.gov) and choose 'Parking Permit' from the **How Do I...?** menu.
- Have the following vehicle information available for **ALL** vehicles:
  - License plate #, Make, Model, Year and Color

### Appeal Process:

- The applicant for a parking permit may appeal the decision to the Community Development Department Director for a "guaranteed second opinion" and if still not satisfied, to the Hearing Officers.
